The EMA Fund is a resource of grants and financial counseling for local women and girls unable to cover the full cost of their abortions. The EMA Fund collaborates with these women, their doctors, and area clinics so that all women may obtain the healthcare they seek.

An all-volunteer organization, the EMA Fund consists of almost 50 dedicated volunteers and an eight-person board of directors. Individuals seeking funding call and leave a message on our voicemail; volunteers check and respond to messages during the weeklong shifts. The board is a collaborative, working board rather than an advisory board, and while board members take on significant organizational responsibilities, there is room to learn new skills, take initiative and be creative. And the impact is direct and real: over 4,000 women have been helped since our inception in 1999.

We are seeking new board members who are committed to reproductive justice and who might add their skills and expertise to our work, particularly those who bring diversity, in terms of race, age, class, ability, and sexual orientation, experience in communications, fundraising, accounting, or financial management, and legal expertise in nonprofit and/or reproductive law.

Our volunteers are currently in the process of updating and revising our mission statement. Please check our website for the new mission statement that should be posted in the next few weeks.
